These awards are designed to recognize local members of the engineering profession for their contribution. Nominees for all awards must either live or work in Westchester/Putnam Counties.

<b><u>Engineer of the Year</u></b> The Chapter's highest award. The award is presented to a professional engineer who is judged to have contributed substantially to the engineering profession.	<b><u>Outstanding Service to the Chapter</u></b> Presented to the Chapter member who has devoted countless hours of time to improve the Chapter's standing in the community and in the profession.
<b><u>Outstanding Engineer in Government</u></b> Presented to the outstanding professional engineer employed by the State, Local or Federal government or agency who has contributed substantially to the engineering profession.	<b><u>Young Engineer of the Year</u></b> Presented to the outstanding young professional who has contributed substantially to the engineering profession. Nominees for this award must be 35 years of age or younger.
<b><u>Outstanding Engineer in Construction</u></b> Presented to the outstanding engineer employed in the construction industry who has contributed substantially to the engineering profession.	<b><u>Outstanding Service to the Profession</u></b> Presented to the individual who has contributed substantially to the engineering profession.
<b><u>Outstanding Engineer in Private Practice</u></b> Presented to the outstanding engineer in private practice who has contributed substantially to the engineering profession.	<b><u>Project of the Year</u></b> Awarded to the outstanding construction project in the current calendar year. Construction must be substantially complete in the current calendar year. The project must be located in either Westchester or Putnam County or designed by a consulting engineering firm located in Westchester or Putnam County. Full color documentation in power point format <u>must</u> be provided for Engineer's Week.

**All nominations must be received prior to 5:00 PM on November 30, 2012.**
